

Access Statement

Pre Arrival:

- For assistance prior to arrival please contact the hotel on 01443 742050 or email enquiries@llechwenhall.co.uk
- Llechwen Hall is 1 mile from the A470 taking the exit for Abercynon.
- The nearest train station is in the village of Abercynon, 2 miles way or 15 minutes by car with trains to Cardiff and Merthyr Tydfil.
- There is a local taxi service that has accessible taxis if required, we can make a booking for you at reception
- Brochures and menus can be provided in large print by prior arrangement
- We have a website (www.llechwenhall.co.uk) and free Wi-Fi throughout the hotel.

Arrival & Car Parking:

- On arrival to the property there is a drive way and a gravel carpark. There are no gates at the entrance.
- There are no marked parking bays but there is ample space for a large number of vehicles and 2 designated disabled spaces are situated directly in front of the hotel.
- The carpark surface is level and flat but is covered with gravel, however there is a concrete which covers the length of the parking facilities to the front entrance and between buildings.
- We can assist guests with parking and luggage.
- The front doors of the hotel can be opened wide to facilitate entry and exit for infirm or disabled guests.

Main Entrance & Reception:

- The front door has one step 7cm high.
- Once through the front doors, the reception area is level with access to the bar and lounge.
- The reception desk is located to the right as you enter the front hall.
- The reception desk is 115 cm high
- The lounge is located to the left as you enter the hall and seating is located in this area.
- The lounge area has level flooring.
- The front door is open between the hours of 6.45am and 11pm. There is an emergency number for outside of these hours.
- The ground floor area is carpeted
- The breakfast room is situated on the ground floor, next to the lounge with a level access.
- The guest registration card can be enlarged if required.
- Brochures and menus can be enlarged upon prior request.



Main Building:

- The main building houses reception, lounge, restaurant and function room with 12 first floor bedrooms.
- Corridors are well lit.
- The flooring on all corridors on the ground floor and first floor are carpet.
- The master staircase is hard wood.
- There are 8 stairs to a landing followed by a further 8 stairs to the first floor bedrooms.
- The stairs are 18cm high, 24cm deep, 85cm wide.
- There are 3 steps down to access bedrooms 3-5 and a further 2 steps down to bedrooms 6-11.

First Floor Bedrooms:

- Door width (main entrance and bathroom) are 80cm wide.
- Double bedded room.
- There is approximately 60cm between the wall and each side of the bed (the bed can move so 120cm total space is available to one side if required).
- There is 2.2 metres free space at the end of the bed to the dressing table and wardrobe with a width of 2.57 metres.
- There is an ensuite shower room (see below for details).
- Bed is 46cm high but can be raised with blocks on request.
- There is a television in the room with subtitles and remote control.
- Fitted short pile carpet on the floor.
- Good contrast in décor.

The Coach House:

- The coach house has 4 ground floor bedrooms and 4 first floor bedrooms.
- The corridors to the ground floor are well lit.
- The flooring on all corridors and bedrooms is carpet.
- There are 16 stairs to the first floor.
- The stairs are 27 cm x 17 cm x 15 cm and are hard wood.

Ground Floor Bedrooms:

- Door widths (main entrance and bathroom) are 78 cm wide.
- Rooms can be adapted to be a double, twin or family room.
- There are 85 cm routes within the bedroom eg. to the side of the bed, between beds and dressing table to allow left or right transfer to beds in any combination.
- Furniture is moveable on request.
- Beds vary in height and width but can be raised with blocks on request.
- There is a television in the room with subtitles and remote control.
- Divan beds and traditional four poster beds are available.
- Two armchairs or sofa and a stool are provided in the room.
- Fitted short pile carpet on floor.



Ensuite Bathrooms:

- Door width of 78cm, inward opening.
- Free floor space clear of door is 155cm x 165cm.
- The bath edge is 47cm high.
- The bath has a shower attachment and both horizontal rail on the opposite side to entry and also vertical rails to the side of the shower attachment.
- A bath seat is available.
- The basin is flat fronted and has clear underspace. It is 86cm high.
- The toilet has left side transfer with available free space of 91cm. The toilet is 46cm high.
- There is a horizontal rail beside the toilet (opposite side to transfer) and 2 vertical rails either side of the toilets cistern tank.
- Good colour contrast of floors, walls, fittings and fixtures.

Further Information Regarding Bedrooms:

- We have a telephone and audio alarm in every bedroom.
- Most bedrooms are generously proportioned but some provide more turning and transfer space than others.
- We try as far as possible to allocate bedrooms based upon individual guests needs.
- Emergency procedures are posted to the door to each bedroom and are explained upon check in for any disabled guests upon request.

Public Areas:

- All Furniture is flexible and can be moved upon request.
- Lighting in public areas is a combination of natural and artificial light.
- Background music is played in the public areas and the volume can be adjusted upon request.

Public WC & Bathrooms:

- · Bedrooms are en-suite and there are public toilets in the main reception corridor, function room and marquee
- There is tiled flooring in all bathrooms and toilets.
- The door to the main reception toilets is 66cm wide.

Garden Marquee:

- The garden marquee can be accessed via a level area round to the rear of the hotel.
- The entrance doors to the marquee can be fully opened to facilitate access.
- The area inside the marguee is flat and the flooring is carpet and vinyl.
- The bar in this room is 98 cm high.

Function Room (Nelson Suite):

- The function room is accessed via a level outside area, round to the side of the building.
- The entrance doors to the room can be fully opened to facilitate access.
- The bar in this room is 98 cm high
- The flooring is carpet with a tiled floor section at the entrance and bar area.



Oak Beam Orangery Restaurant:

- Access to the restaurant is via the main lobby, with 3 steps down. Alternatively level access is available around the outside of the hotel and through the Orangery doors.
- Menus can be provided in large print.

Grounds & Gardens:

- We have surrounding gardens with outdoor seating available in the summer season.
- Walk ways are open to the public.

Additional Information:

- Dogs are welcome at the hotel.
- Mobile phone reception is generally good.
- We are able to use the front and back doors in the need of evacuation, the fire alarm rings continuously if evacuation is needed. If you require more assistance for evacuating please notify us on arrival.
- We are happy to take delivery of hired equipment, please just let us know by using the contact number below.
- We are a no smoking building smoking is allowed in dedicated spaces outside which have level entry and bins cigarette bins provided.
- Medication can be held in our fridge. Please contact reception for further information.
